CONTRACTING WITH SMALL AND MINORITY BUSINESSES, WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE AND LABOR SURPLUS FIRMS

It is federal policy to solicit contracts to small, women and minority business firms when federal grant funds are expended. Accordingly, affirmative steps must be taken to assure that small and minority/women businesses are utilized when possible as sources of supplies, equipment, construction and services. Affirmative steps shall include the following:

1. Including qualified small and minority/women businesses on solicitation lists.

Grantees are encouraged to procure goods and services from labor surplus areas.

Grantor agencies may impose additional regulations and requirements in the foregoing areas only to the extent specifically mandated by statute or presidential direction.

West Virginia Code §5A-3-59 and **Code of Federal Regulations**, Title 13, Part 121 defines and establishes contracting with small and minority businesses, women business enterprise and labor surplus firms. - **Hispanic American** means a person having origins in any of the Spanish-speaking peoples of Mexico, South or Central America, or the Caribbean Islands or other Spanish or Portuguese cultures and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.
- **Native American** means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is recognized by a tribal organization

Small Business means a business, independently owned or operated by one or more persons who are citizens of the United States or noncitizens who are in full compliance with United States immigration law, which, together with affiliates, has two hundred fifty or fewer employees, or average annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the previous three years.
