Additional Information:

ALL BEGINNING TEACHERS - Be aware of your teacher certification expiration date. Your teacher certification expires three years from the date but was first issued. Please be sure to complete six college or university hours to renew it.

Alternative Certification - Prior to being accepted into the **Alternative Certification Program, applicants must complete the Praxis CORE Knowledge Exam for Educators in Reading, Writing, and Math (Combined Test #5751) (Some applicants will receive a waiver for this exam based on identified criteria.)

Prior to being accepted into the **Alternative Certification Program, applicants must complete the appropriate Praxis Content Exam for the school instructional level employment is desired in Mathematics, Sciences, English Language Arts, or World Languages.

All teachers hired into the Alternate Certification Program for Special Education Multi-categorical BD, LD, MI/ID (Praxis # 5543) or Autism Praxis Content Exam (#5354) must complete the Praxis Content Exams before finishing the program. The Alternative Teaching Certificate can only be renewed twice.

All teachers in the Alternative Certification Program must successfully complete the Praxis ***Principals of Learning and Teaching (PLT) Grades K-6 #5622, Grades 5-9 5623 (except in areas of special education) or Grades 7-12 5624. Those in areas of special education must take PLT #5624.

The PLT must be successfully completed for the grade levels you re teaching.

** To be admitted into alternative certification, you must be hired into a position after meeting all pre-hiring requisites and being selected.

*** Special Ed can complete PLT #5622 for elementary school (K-6) or PLT #5624 for secondary schools (7-12). Special Ed do not complete the PLT for grades 5-9.

Those electing grades 5-9 alternative certification for middle school must successfully complete TWO Praxis Content Exams (example: ELA and Spanish).

Electronic Register Online (ERO) is our staff development registration system.
