Using students to canvass homes in the interest of money-raising activities is not permitted or sanctioned by the Board of Education or the local school administrative staff.

Pep clubs, student councils, and other school organizations may sell school-spirit builders and pep club materials within the school. The sale by the school of articles of clothing such as sweaters, shoes, shirts, et cetera, is prohibited in the community. Sponsor clubs, booster groups, and parent-teacher associations, in setting up projects for raising money, may not rely on door to door sale by students.

School carnivals are approved. Kings and queens may not be elected by selling votes.

Games of chance, promotions involving games of chance, raffles, bingo games, blind drawings et cetera, are not sanctioned or permitted as fund raisers.
