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20.01 Instructional Day. Pursuant to WV State Board Policy 2510, all students shall be scheduled for the full instructional day for all four years in grades 9-12.

Exceptions that would allow students to be scheduled for less than the full instructional day are as follows:

20.01.1 Enrollment in dual credit and/or college courses.

20.01.2 Enrollment in ~~advanced vocational career~~/technical programs.

20.01.3 Enrollment in WV Virtual School or ~~KCS Online High School~~ courses.

20.01.4 Participation in apprenticeships or internships only if related to career major and part of a Personalized Education ~~Individualized Student Transition~~ Plan.

20.01.5 Participation in Distributive Marketing or ~~Cooperative~~ Education programs that require part time employment.

20.01.6 Existence of a compelling circumstance (i.e., medical condition, etc.). Such cases must be approved by the superintendent.

20.01.7 At the discretion of the Superintendent of Schools in response to an academic incentive initiative.

20.02 Annual Attendance Report. Each county shall submit an annual attendance report to the Department of Education covering each school housing students in any grade 9-12. The report shall list the number of students in each of those schools scheduled for less than the full instructional day and the reasons, based on the county policy, for the exceptions granted.
