

## **IEP Amendments**

In making changes to a student's IEP after the annual IEP meeting for a school year, the parent/adult student and the district may agree, in writing, not to convene an IEP meeting for the purposes of making minor changes, and instead, may develop a written document to amend the student's current IEP. Districts must document the changes made to the IEP on the IEP Amendment Form and provide a copy to the parents. Upon request, a parent or adult student will be provided with a revised copy of the IEP with amendments incorporated. The annual review date remains the date of the original IEP. The IEP Team members and other service provider(s) impacted by amendments must be informed of the changes to the IEP.
