

POWERFUL PARTNERS

Parents and Guardians,

You are powerful partners in education and learning does not have to end in the classroom. How can you help at home? Here are some engaging activities that will support learning at home and help your child become more successful in their studies.

READING

Informative/Explanatory Writing

- Ask your child to explain or write a paragraph about what it means to be grateful. Share this with your family during the holiday break.
- Ask your child to have some fun and create their own Thanksgiving recipe. It can be silly or a new recipe to use this holiday season. (Focus on transitional words like: First, Second, Then, Next, and Finally.)
- Your child can write a thank you letter to someone who is important in their life. The letter should be at least one paragraph.



MATH

Understand ratio concepts and use ratio reasoning to solve problems.

- Have your child go to the grocery store with you and determine the unit rate of items based on the number of items and cost. (6 paper towels cost \$3.89, how much does one cost?)
- Have your child determine if it is best to buy single items or packs of 2, or 6 of different items at the store.
- Have your child compare different brands of items to see if they are cheaper unit rates for the same amount of items.
