Did you know that your child has access to the McGraw Hill ALEKS program?

In this program, students take an initial knowledge check and pieces of a "pie" chart are filled in. Students work through topics they are ready to learn and new topics are opened up throughout the year.

Here is how you can see your child's information and have a conversation with them regarding the program:

Select the Main Navigation Menu in the upper left corner and then select Reports.



The *Report Dashboard* displays quick overviews of important data applicable to your progress in ALEKS. You can move the tiles around by selecting the icon in the upper-right corner of a tile. Choosing the arrow at the bottom of the page will navigate to a second page of report tiles. Selecting *View Full Report* on a tile will give you more detailed information about that report.



There is also an SAT Pathway that is free for students to use and study for the SAT. If it has not been assigned to your child, have your child ask their teacher if it can be added.
