## Understanding Division

- Divide 12 objects into 3 equal groups. How many are in each group? Have your child tell you the answers that would go in the blanks: 12 counters were divided into
$\qquad$ groups (3). There are $\qquad$ counters in each group (4). So 12 divided by 3 equals $\qquad$ in each group (4).
- Give your child 4 more problems like the one above in \#l. Give them questions like the ones above and have them fill in the blanks with the new information from the numbers you provide.


## Understanding Division

- Draw 2 boxes on your child's paper. Have them partition (divide into equal parts) 8 counters one at a time to find the number of counters in each group. If they do this with physical objects, have them draw the objects in the boxes and then answer the question: There are $\qquad$ objects in each group. (4)
- Have your child do this same type of activity 4 more times like we did in problem \#1.
