Figurative Language

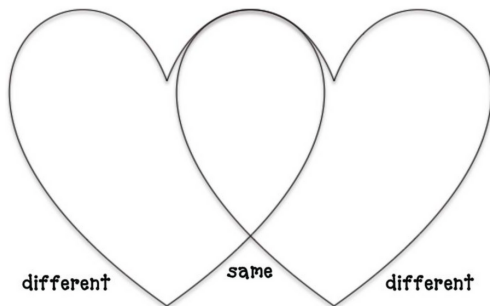
Write a simile about love or happiness and then use it to create a Valentine's Day card for a friend, parent or teacher. Don't forget to include the simile.
