Write a metaphor about love or happiness and then use it to create a Valentine's Day card for a friend, parent or teacher. Don't forget to include the metaphor.

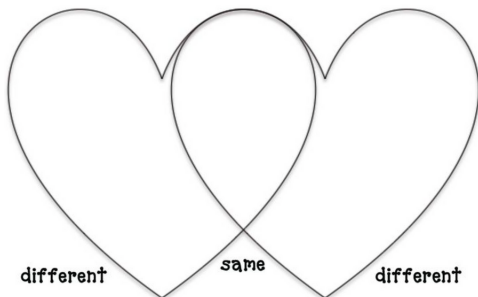
Metaphor - directly comparing two unlike things.

MATH

Rate each of the following problems and provide a review for your ranking. For example: if the problem said $2 * 2 + 4$, and I wrote down $4+4 = 8$, I could get 5 stars because I was correct and showed all of my work. If the problem was $(2+4)-9$ and I said the answer is 3, I may get two stars because I wrote $6-9=3$. The review may say that I knew to do the parenthesis first, but I just made a subtraction error afterwards.
