

READING

Compute fluency with multidigit numbers and find common factors and multiples

- Divide using the standard algorithm:
 3248 divided by 16 (Answer: 203)
- Divide using the standard algorithm:
 3399 divided by 11 (Answer: 309)
- Multiply using the standard algorithm: 28*12 (Answer: 336)
- Multiply using the standard algorithm:
 14*19 (Answer: 266)
